Dear friends in Christ,

After each Mass this weekend there will be an opportunity to **sign up to attend a listening session**. Our parish is holding this "Listening Campaign" to better understand the pressures facing families and individuals in our parish. Our parish is concerned about the pressures facing families, and we have joined with other Catholic parishes and other congregations in the metro area to form the Oklahoma Sponsoring Committee so that together we can take action on those issues that are important to families and to our neighborhoods. Based on what is heard in our Listening Campaign, we may identify ways our parish's ministries can be more effective in addressing the immediate needs of people. We may also identify situations that are beyond our capacity as a parish to address that need to be brought to the attention of public officials. In no way will this Listening Campaign lead to supporting or endorsing political candidates or a political party, nor will it lead to participation in marches or protests. Instead, it will create a non-partisan way for people to participate in the decisions that affect their lives, which is what democracy is all about.

At least one of the members of our Interfaith Organizing Committee will host each listening session. These sessions are limited to 10-12 people, will last only one hour, and there are many options on times and places. Anyone can attend. These sessions are not about problem-solving or debating, but simply to **give each person who comes an opportunity to briefly share the biggest pressure**, concern, or worry facing them and/or their family. One key to the success of this venture is that those who share the pressures they struggle with must also be willing to help find solutions to these challenges.

The month of January is designated as "*Poverty in America Awareness Month*." See this web-site for more information: www.usccb.org/cchd/povertyusa/povamer.shtml. Archbishop Beltran has asked parishes throughout our archdiocese to take up a **collection for the Haitian relief effort**. We will take up this collection this weekend, and our archdiocese will send all monies collected to Catholic Relief Services.

Michael Reardon & Patrick Lane present "*The Gospel of Luke*" Thursday at 7 p.m. (*childcare provided*), our annual **party for volunteers** is Saturday at 6 p.m., and next Sunday evening there will be a **bunko party** hosted by parish staff members to raise money for the new church.
