The generosity of parishioners for the past 50 years has made possible a Catholic school at our parish. Calls to this number will be answered by the Archdiocesan Assistance Coordinator who will offer to meet with the caller in person (if desired by caller), assist in making a formal complaint to the Archdiocese, arrange a personal meeting with the Archbishop or his representative and obtain support and pastoral counseling.

Calls are confidential with the following exceptions of:

- Any allegation of sexual or physical abuse or neglect of minors must be reported to the Oklahoma Department of Human Services (1.800.522.3511) as required by Oklahoma Laws and Archdiocesan policies.
- Any allegation of sexual misconduct must be shared with the proper Archdiocesan authorities.
- Local law enforcement agencies may also be contacted.

You may also contact: the Oklahoma DHS Services (esp. if victim is a minor); the law enforcement agency (police); local child protection agencies, private attorney and/or a support group.
