Last Sunday was the annual ADF appeal. If you have not yet made a pledge to support the ministries of our Archdiocese, please fill out a pledge form, and drop it in the collection basket or mail it in. Remember to put "St. Eugene Church, OKC" on the parish line of the pledge form. In the past, a parish ID# was printed on the pledge forms sent to each parish, but postal security regulations prevent that now. Thanks to Mark Knutson for coordinating this year's Annual Archdiocesan Appeal, and to his three sons---Daniel, Ryan, and Erik--for helping put the ADF envelopes in the pew pockets.

Ash Wednesday is this Wednesday. Every year our parish gives alms by giving away our Ash Wednesday collection to an organization in the local community that helps those who are in need. This year's collection will go to Mustard Seed, which works with the poor within our eastern parish boundaries and whose Executive Director is one of our own parishioners, Dan Short. In your personal almsgiving, please support the good works of our local St. Vincent de Paul Conference, by placing donations in the poor box at the back of church (under the icon of St. Vincent de Paul) or by using the envelopes in your envelope packet. Also, another option for almsgiving is by donating to the BritVil Community Food Pantry which provides food for the hungry in the Britton/Village neighborhoods. This food pantry fed 5,664 families last year and is in need of a few more financial gifts to finish up a capital campaign to build a new building for their ministry. Information on this can be found on the countertop in the gathering area.

During Catholic Schools Week at the school Mass, our school principal, **Suzette Williams, was honored as "Distinguished Graduate of the Year."** Suzette is in her 7th year as principal here, and it has been a blessing to have one of our own alums serve our school so well as principal.

LENTEN REGULATIONS

Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years old and older on Ash Wednesday and on all the Fridays of Lent. Fasting is to be observed on Ash Wednesday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59. Those who are bound by this may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted. The special Paschal fast and abstinence are prescribed for Good Friday and encouraged for Holy Saturday.
