**Dear Friends in Christ,**

I had 2 experiences last week of the vibrancy of the Church in Oklahoma. On Sunday night at the Cathedral I attended the Rite of Election with our catechumens and baptized candidates who will be joining the Church this Easter, along with their godparents or sponsors and catechists. The church was packed with people from all over the Archdiocese coming to be welcomed into the Church by Archbishop Beltran. There were 2 other Rites of Election earlier in the day, each one celebrated in a packed Cathedral, with only enough room for catechumens and their godparents and candidates and their sponsors. **Which means there are over 1000 people joining the Church** in our Archdiocese this Easter!

On Saturday at the 14<sup>th</sup> Annual Men's Conference in Norman between 700-800 men from all over Oklahoma spent a day listening to inspiring speakers about our Faith. The new location for the conference at the Embassy Suites worked great. Plus, there were **at least 100 young men** (high-school and college-age) in attendance. When one speaker asked for those to stand up who were thinking about serving the Church as a priest, about 20 stood up.

We will need those men to make a formal commitment and enter the seminary to study for the priesthood, because our archdiocese is not ordaining anyone to the priesthood this year, and we have 3 priests retiring from active ministry. Plus, there will be one fewer of the priests from India helping out. I am still convinced that there is at least one man in our parish who is being called to the priesthood. Continue to pray for priestly vocations and verbally encourage someone who you think might make a good priest to pursue this vocation.

Archbishop Beltran marks 50 years as a priest this May, and there will be a **special celebration** at the youth camp for him that month. See the bulletin announcement under "*Community Life*" for more details. A number of you have inquired about Fr. Ross' health. **He is doing fine**. He is away on an 8-day retreat in California and will be back at the parish on March 6<sup>th</sup>.

The Rice Bowls have finally arrived and are in the gathering area for those who would like to use them. Also, around \$200,000 was donated by the people of our Archdiocese to **aid the people of Haiti** through *Catholic Relief Services*.
