LENTEN REGULATIONS

Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years old and older on Ash Wednesday and on all the Fridays of Lent. Fasting is to be observed on Ash Wednesday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59. Those who are bound by this may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted. The special Paschal fast and abstinence are prescribed for Good Friday and encouraged for Holy Saturday.

Catholic Bishops Urge Participation in 2010 Census

Through the Secretariat of Cultural Diversity in the Church, the US Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) is partnering with the US Census Bureau to encourage participation in the Census 2010, in order to reach hard-to-count communities. Archbishop Jose Gomez, chairman of the USCCB Committee on Cultural Diversity, urges parishes and dioceses to encourage local people to participate and states, "Pastors have a responsibility to know their flock ... The US Census is a useful tool for learning about God's people, who and where they are, and many other facts that shed light on their lives, possibilities and struggles ..." The questionnaire is short and easy and takes about 10 minutes to complete. **The information gathered by the Census is confidential and only shared in aggregate numbers (statistics) once the surveys are completed.**
