Dear Friends in Christ,

The "**Liturgical Ministers Morning of Reflection**" will take place this Saturday, March 27th from 9:00 a.m. – 11:30 a.m. This event is for those who are presently serving as lectors, communion ministers, ushers, greeters, and in the choir and also for those who would like to serve in one of these ministries. There will be a keynote address given by Fr. Lafferty followed by 2 breakout sessions for each liturgical ministry, one theological in nature and the other a practical review of the duties of each ministry. In the past this Morning of Reflection was opened to the entire parish, but this year it is for liturgical ministers only, and for those who want to serve in one of these ministries.

This **Thursday night, March 25th, at 7 p.m.** is our **Communal Lenten Penance Service**. There will be a brief prayer service followed by the offering of the Sacrament of Reconciliation to those who would like to go to Confession. There are not many opportunities left to celebrate this Sacrament before Easter. Confessions will be offered this coming Saturday afternoon from 3:00 – 4:30 p.m., and this Wednesday and next Wednesday (March 24 and 31) from 12:30 – 1:30 p.m. and from 8:00 – 9:00 p.m. Confessions will not be heard on Holy Saturday, April 3rd.

This week a portion of the sale of the house belonging to deceased parishioner Beverly Reeves will be given to our parish---approximately \$140,000. Our **New Church Fund** will receive \$100,000 of this gift and the **remaining \$40,000** will go as a **down payment on a house our parish is buying directly north of the rectory** on Greystone Avenue. The remainder will be paid off in a ten-year loan with rent payments paying this monthly mortgage. Someone has already agreed to rent this house starting the first week of April. With this purchase our parish now owns all the property on the east side of Greystone Avenue from Hefner Road to the 2 empty lots south of Utica Drive (road leading into the school parking lot) with the exception of one remaining house, the one closest to Hefner Road.
