**Dear Friends in Christ,**

Children in grades 3<sup>rd</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> will be making their First Holy Communion this weekend at the 5 p.m. Sunday Vigil Mass (Saturday), and the 10 a.m. and 12 noon Masses on Sunday. Next weekend our 2<sup>nd</sup> grade students will receive their First Holy Communion, and there will be some of these young children at each of the weekend Masses. Seeing how excited these children are to receive Holy Communion always makes me reflect on what a great gift we have been given in the Eucharist. As Catholics, we can receive the Lord's Body and Blood every day at Mass if we desire to do so. As with all good gifts that God sends our way, we can take for granted the gift of the Eucharist. Our First Communicants remind us each year to see with fresh eyes what we are being given every time we come to Mass—the gift of the Son of God himself, who out of love grants us a share in His divine life, drawing us into Communion with the Father and Spirit and into communion with each other.

As was announced last Sunday, our parish recently received a \$484,000 gift from the estate of Beverly Reeves. (Originally the gift from the Reeves' estate was projected to be around \$140,000.) Of this \$484,000 gift, around \$33,000 has been used as a down payment on the house our parish purchased on Greystone Avenue immediately north of the rectory. (The monthly rent pays the mortgage payment on the \$60,000 loan for this house.) The remaining \$451,000 has been deposited in our New Church Fund, bringing our total cash and pledges very close to \$6 million for our New Church Capital Campaign, "A Legacy of Faith: Raising Up a Holy Place." So, we are now much closer to our \$6.77 million campaign goal. Deacon Bill Bawden and I, along with representatives from our Capital Campaign Committee, Finance Committee, and New Church Design Committee will be meeting with the Archdiocesan Finance Council on May 11<sup>th</sup> to discuss our options on how to move forward from here. All parishioners are invited to pray a novena using the "Prayer for the Building of the New Church" from May 3 – May 11<sup>th</sup>.

The members of our Capital Campaign Committee will be hosting a reception for those who have joined our parish since April 2009 to share with these new parishioners information about our new church and the effort to raise funds to build it. Invitations were sent out last week. If for some reason you did not receive an invitation, and you have registered in our parish in the past year, please feel free to attend this reception on Wednesday night at 7 p.m. in the meeting rooms. Food and drink will be served. Please call the parish office at 751-7115 to RSVP so the committee can make appropriate plans. Childcare will be provided.
