Dear Friends in Christ,

Next Sunday is Mother's Day and also the time for donations to help mothers in problem pregnancies through the work of **Birth Choice**. Donations help keep the doors open at four Birth Choice centers in the metro area as well as Rose Home, a shelter for homeless pregnant women and their children. Monies raised help provide pregnancy testing, limited ultrasounds, prenatal medical assessments, prenatal vitamins, shelter and food through Rose Home, maternity and infant clothing, and diapers and formula. Birth Choice assisted 18,468 women in 2009, a 17% increase from 2008. In your envelope packet there is an envelope designated for Birth Choice –you can place this envelope in the regular collection at any time.

Tomorrow (Monday) is the first day of the novena of prayer for the success of our meeting with the Archdiocesan Finance Committee on May 11th. Please pray the "Prayer for the New Church" every day from May 3-11.

A new sound system has been installed in the church at the cost of \$1600. A new organ is also needed, for our present organ is on its last legs. The cost of a new organ is not included in the new church fundraising goal. Hopefully there will be donations to purchase a new organ for the new church building. Abuse of Minors Pastoral Response Hotline

For the safety of children and the healing of victims, the Archdiocese of OKC provides this hotline for reporting the abuse of a minor (past or present) by a member of the clergy or other church personnel. Calls to this number will be answered by the Archdiocesan Assistance Coordinator who will offer to meet with the caller in person (if desired by caller), assist in making a formal complaint to the Archdiocese, arrange a personal meeting with the Archbishop or his representative and obtain support and pastoral counseling.

Calls are confidential with the following exceptions of:

- Any allegation of sexual or physical abuse or neglect of minors must be reported to the Oklahoma Department of Human Services (1.800.522.3511) as required by Oklahoma Laws and Archdiocesan policies.
- Any allegation of sexual misconduct must be shared with the proper Archdiocesan authorities.
- Local law enforcement agencies may also be contacted.

You may also contact: the Oklahoma DHS (esp. if victim is a minor); the law enforcement agency (police); local child protection agencies, private attorney and/or a support group.
