With this green light, our architects at Architectural Design Group can now finish the construction documents (they were already 75% complete) and put these documents out to bid by contractors. I will have a more exact timeline for you by next week, but it looks like groundbreaking for our new church will take place sometime this Fall. It will take 12-18 months to build the church once ground is broken. I am in New York this weekend to celebrate a relative's wedding, so next weekend I will speak at Mass in more detail about this next step in our efforts to leave a legacy of faith by raising up a holy place.

Thanks to Mary, Barbara, Kathy, and to all who helped make the picnic a wonderful celebration!
