**Dear Friends in Christ,**

**Happy Father's Day!** Fr. Dan Doyle, who was here last weekend to speak about the good work of Christian Foundation for Children and Aging (CFCA), shared with me how much he enjoyed the hospitality of our parishioners. 65 parishioners signed up to sponsor a child or an elderly person thru CFCA.

From 14 inches of snow on Christmas Eve, to a major hailstorm on May 16, to the torrential downpour and floods of this past week, the weather has been wreaking havoc on our church facilities as well as on the homes of many parishioners. Since the roofs over our parish facilities that were damaged by the hailstorm had not yet been replaced, the torrential rain brought leaks to our buildings. The nursery, which also serves as the Extended Care/Summer Camp office, is drying out and a new carpet will be installed in that room, as well as new carpet installed in the room right next to the nursery—our office for Hispanic Ministry. So, some of our parish staff will be in temporary locations during the storm clean up and repair.

After the 90 days of the Lenten-Easter Season and the two Solemnities following upon that Season (Holy Trinity and the Body and Blood of Christ), we returned last Sunday to the numbered Sundays in Ordinary Time and the evangelist Luke's account of Jesus' Galilean ministry. On this 12<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time, Peter answers Jesus' question, "*Who do you say that I am,*" and then Jesus lays out the cost of discipleship. Next Sunday, we will enter a new section of Luke's Gospel, the "*Journey to Jerusalem,*" as the Lucan Jesus walks the road to his destiny in Jerusalem, where he will suffer, die, rise, and ascend into heaven. Along the road he teaches his disciples the qualities of discipleship. We will be travelling through this section of Luke's Gospel until the 30<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time on October 31<sup>st</sup>. It will only be interrupted by the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary in August, which falls on a Sunday this year.

I will be in Ft. Smith from Monday night until Thursday evening for Module III of "*Good Leaders, Good Shepherds.*"
