Dear Friends in Christ,

The 29th Anniversary of Fr. Stanley Rother's death is this Wednesday, July 28th. For almost 3 years our archdiocese has taken testimony from those who knew Fr. Rother here and in Guatemala and examined all correspondence relating to him (homilies, letters, etc.) All this is now being sent on to the Vatican. Please take one of the prayer cards from the little shrine to Fr. Rother near the front door, and pray that he will be declared a saint. Next year, the 30th anniversary of Fr. Rother's death, Archbishop Beltran will lead a pilgrimage to Santiago Atitlan, Guatemala during the last week of July.

Fr. Rother gave his life in the cause of Social Justice, becoming a voice for those who had none in Santiago Atitlan. **Mr. Jack Jezreel, executive director of JustFaith, will be at our parish this Thursday at 6 p.m.** to speak about seeking God's justice in a world where there is still too much injustice. I have heard Mr. Jezreel speak, and he does a great job communicating the social teachings of the Church in an easily understandable manner.

Upon the recommendation of our Search Committee for a Coordinator of Youth and Young Adult Ministry, **Cristina Vizcaino was hired at the end of June for this position.** (Cristina had been working in this position on an interim basis since the end of last year.) Thanks to Robyn Duginski, chair of the Search Committee and to the other members: Jan Latta, Gloria Pantazis, Judi Wilkinson, Lori Canfield and Imelda Aleman.

The title of Cristina's position has been carefully chosen---she is the Coordinator for this ministry, which means she needs the assistance of adults for our youth ministry to flourish.

During the summer months our Sunday collection dips as parishioners take vacations. However, the bills that have to be paid do not go on vacation. Please consider catching up on your contributions when you return from vacation or **signing up for auto-withdrawal**, which allows for support of our parish here or away. These forms can be found on the countertop in the gathering area.

Next weekend is **Lance Warren's last weekend with us as our summer seminarian.** There will be a reception after the 10 a.m. Mass next Sunday. Our parish has been blessed to have Lance with us---send him off with a card or personal greeting of thanks and pray for him.
