Dear Friends in Christ,

As I mentioned last weekend at the Masses where the various Commission members were blessed, the following Commissions need more members: **Administration** (Deacon Bill Bawden), **Community Life** (Carol Ann Combs), and **Outreach** (Gloria Pantazis). If you are interested in serving on one of these Commissions, and have been or presently are a member of one of the ministries under their supervision, please contact the Staff Resource person listed above in parentheses.

This weekend at all the Masses one of the members of our School Advisory Council will speak about this year's "Friends of St. Eugene" tuition assistance appeal. Gifts made to this appeal help students for this school year who need tuition assistance. On the other hand, gifts to the School Scholarship Endowment Fund will provide tuition aid in the future through interest on that fund once it reaches \$500,000. The present balance is \$417,000.

A number of parents become frustrated with the decision of their children to leave the Catholic Church for another church or when they simply stop coming to Mass. St. Monica understands the pain and struggle of parents, because she was the mother of a dissipated, hedonistic young man who grew up to be St. Augustine. (St. Monica's feast day was Friday, Aug. 27 and St. Augustine's was Sat., Aug. 28th.) St. Monica prayed fervently for her son's conversion, and parents can imitate Monica's example by loving their children and praying for them, even when parents disagree with their children's choices. Here's a prayer that asks God for this kind of help, called the "St. Monica Prayer."

"Holy God, you gave St. Monica a spirit of selfless love manifested in her constant prayer for the conversion of her son, Augustine. Inspired by boundless confidence in your power to move hearts, and by the success of her prayer, I ask the grace to imitate her constancy in my prayer for [name(s)] who no longer share(s) in the intimate life of your Catholic family. Grant through my prayer and witness that (he/she/they) may be open to the promptings of you Holy Spirit, and return to loving union with your Church. Grant also that my prayer be every hopeful and that I may never judge another, for You alone can read hearts. I ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen."
