Dear Friends in Christ,

Lent ends on Holy Thursday just before the Mass of the Lord's Supper. We turn our gaze from the 40 days of Lent, that marathon of discipline, to the Three Days, that sleepless time out of time, that interlude of grace. These Three Days have a unique name: Triduum. It is a strange word to many people. This word comes from the Latin words for "Three Days" and because of its mysterious, solemn sound, the word "Triduum" conveys the gravity of this time. The Three Days are Friday, Saturday, and Sunday, but we start counting them on Thursday night. Each of the days begins the night before as the most important liturgical feasts do. Although we call this time "the Three Days," in spirit it is really one event. What we start on Holy Thursday we finish on Easter Sunday: one long glorious day.

Clear your calendar for the Triduum! This can be hard if you are not prepared for it, but it is essential if you want to enter into a spiritual retreat like none other. Starting Thursday evening, set aside ordinary activities and give full attention to the holiest days of the year. Take off work. Avoid purely social gatherings. Do not go to the movies, concerts, or sporting events. Stay off line. Leave your car in the garage as much as possible. Forgo television, distracting music, talk radio, and time at the computer. Minimize phone calls and conversations. Savor the silence. **Above all, make time for the three most important liturgies of the Church year:** the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, the Passion of Our Lord Jesus Christ on Good Friday, and the Great Easter Vigil during the night of Holy Saturday. Something wonderful is about to happen. Create an environment to welcome it. Clear your calendar for the Triduum! **In the peace of Christ, Fr. Joseph A. Jacobi**
